

Phrasal Verbs with 'Run'

Run About

- **run about**

1. also **run around**: be very busy doing a lot of different things; run in a rushed or disorganized way; frisk:

- Stop running about and have some breakfast.

Run Into

- **run into** somebody or something

1. collide, crash into something:

- She ran into a tree when she was parking. — Она врезалась в дерево, когда парковалась.

2. meet somebody unexpectedly:

- I ran into her in the store and didn't even recognize her.
