

Wiki Syntax

Wiki syntax is a markup language that is used to format text on websites (usually belonging to the class of wiki projects) and allows you to simplify access to the capabilities of the [W HTML](#) language. Pages, designed using wiki markup, are pre-converted to HTML for viewing in a web browser, the conversion is implemented by special software - [W wiki software](#) (wiki engine).

Various wiki markup languages do not have a generally accepted standard and are incompatible with each other. The wikibook site [ESL.Wiki](#) runs on the DokuWiki engine and uses the appropriate kind of markup. The basics of DokuWiki markup can be found on the page "[Basic formatting constructs](#)".
